The History

Since the early 20th century, 119 E Colorado Blvd has been woven into the fabric of Pasadena's commercial identity as the longtime headquarters of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce. Colorado Boulevard — the city's historic main street and the iconic route of the Tournament of Roses Parade — has drawn visitors, residents, and retailers for well over a hundred years. Today, this landmark building offers prospective tenants the rare combination of irreplaceable historic character and one of Southern California's most enduring high-street retail addresses.

Completed in 1906 and designed by the celebrated Los Angeles firm Parkinson and Bergstrom, the Chamber of Commerce Building is one of Old Pasadena's earliest skyscrapers and a defining landmark of Colorado Boulevard. The civic organization that once called it home played an instrumental role in shaping the city itself — championing the construction of the iconic Colorado Street Bridge and driving the bond effort that produced Pasadena's grand City Hall, Auditorium, and Public Library.

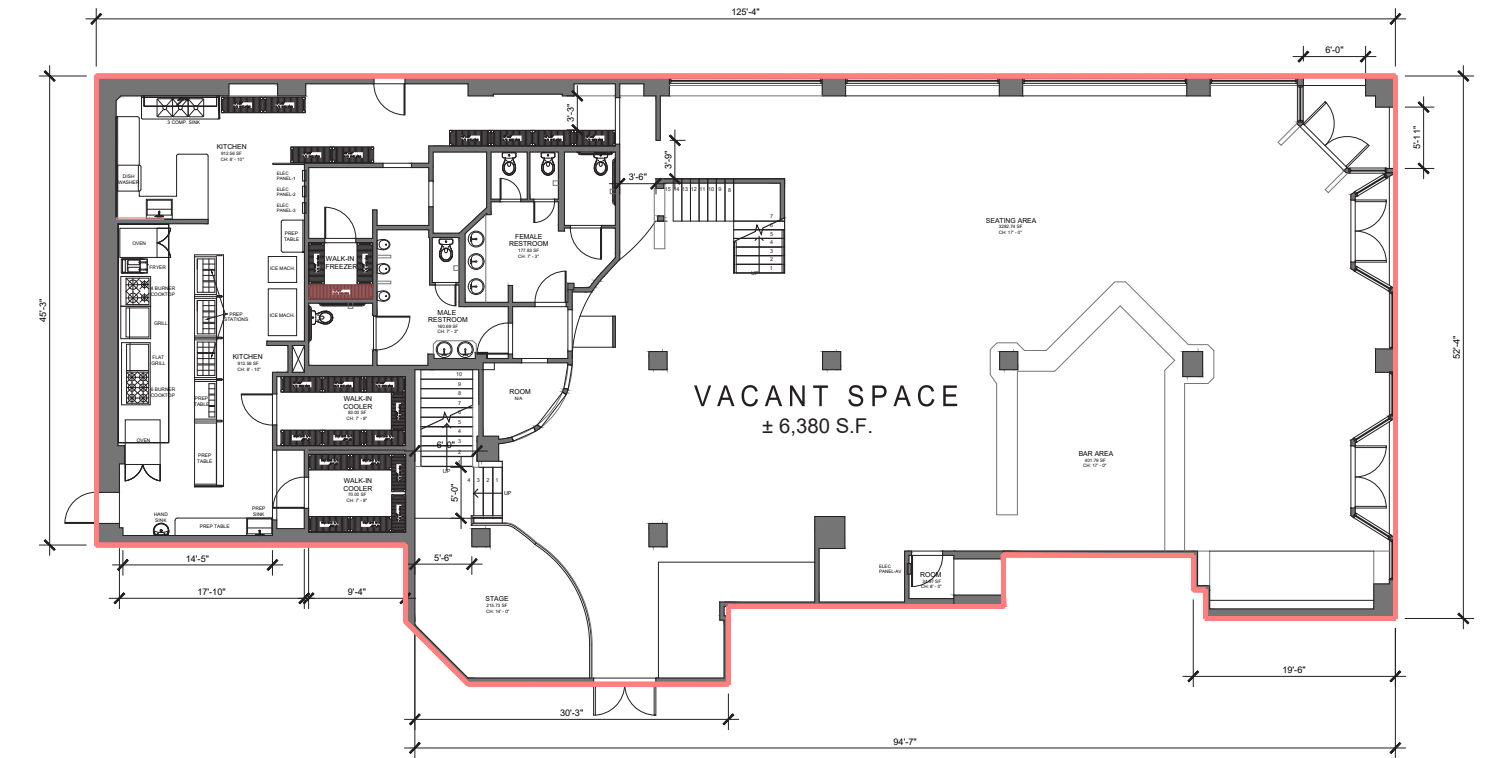
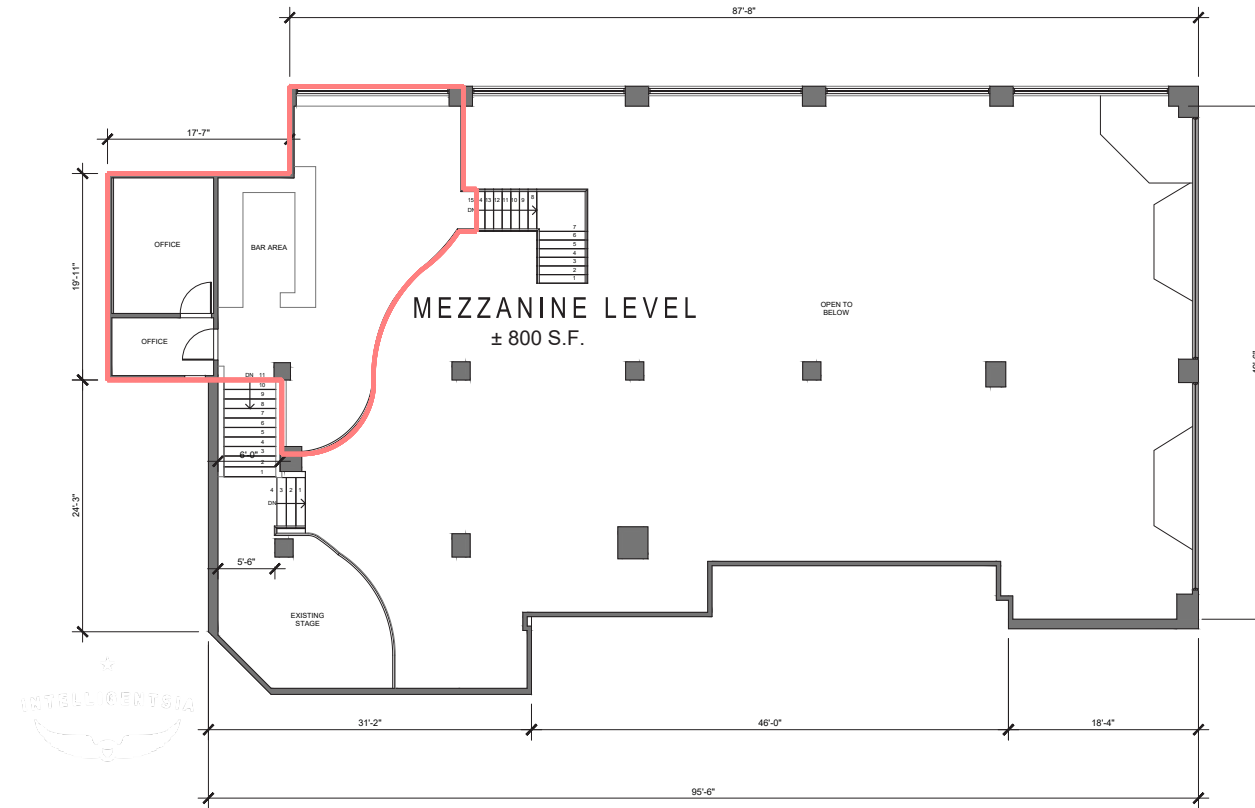

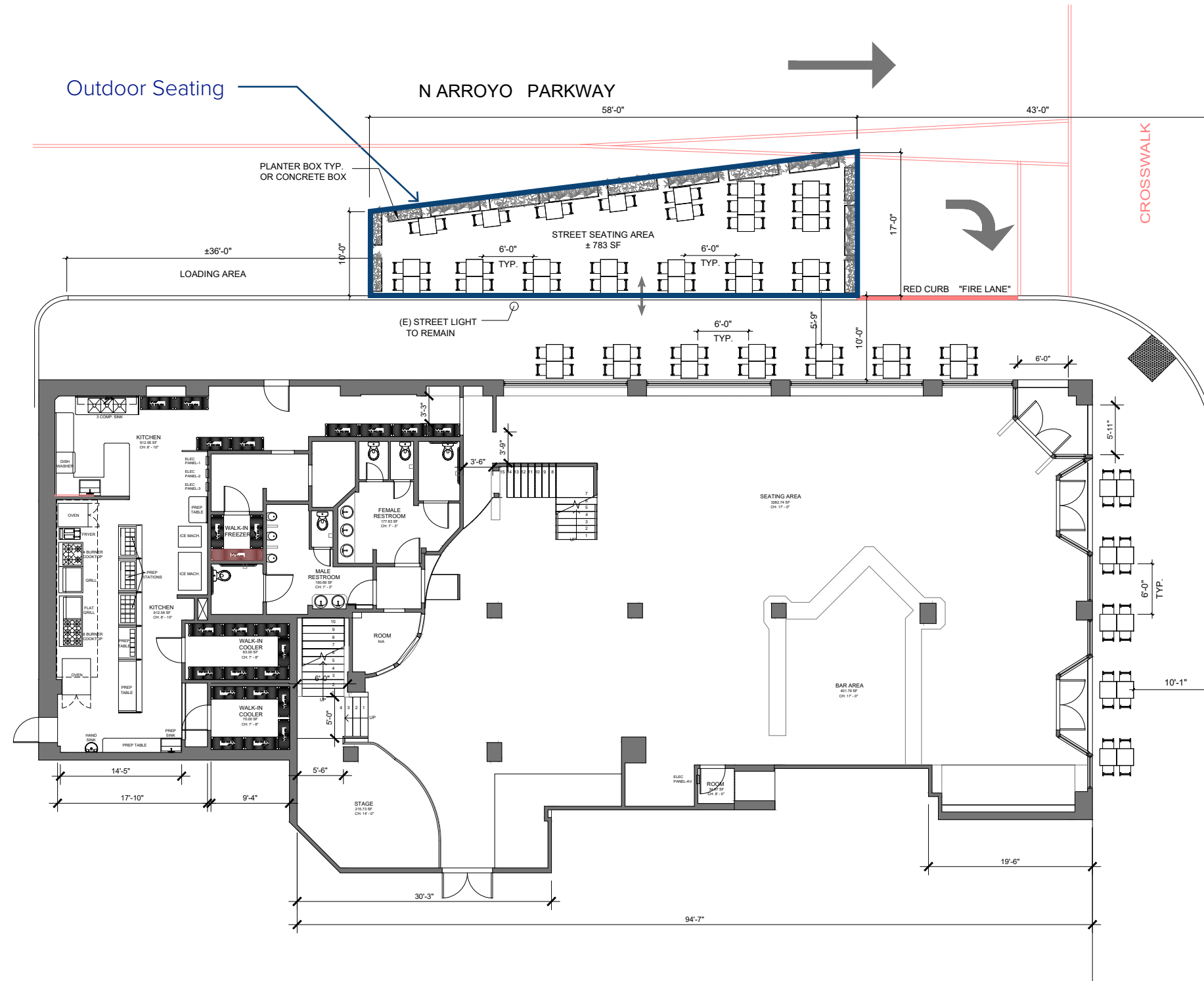


Floor Plan

The historic Chamber of Commerce Building occupies one of Old Pasadena's most storied corners — Colorado Boulevard and Arroyo Parkway — placing ground-floor retailers directly within Southern California's most walkable and well-trafficked retail districts. A dense mix of premier brands, chef-driven dining, and lifestyle tenants lines the surrounding corridor, while cultural anchors like the Pasadena Playhouse and a packed calendar of signature events ensure consistent foot traffic well beyond the standard retail day.
